Vendor Guidelines



Space Assignment: Your space will be assigned upon check-in the morning of the event.

Hours: Set up is between 7am– 9 am. All vehicles must be off event site by 9 am. Tear down is 2 - 4 pm. One parking space per vendor is provided. Please lock your vehicle, the Mission will not be held responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen items.

Space and Product Specifications: Retail & Artisan spaces are 10x10; food spaces are 10x15. 10x20 spaces are available for an additional fee. Only space is provided. Vendors are responsible for tables, canopies, chairs, etc.

Product Specifications: The sale of weapons, firearms, explosives (including ammunition, fireworks, snap caps, bomb bags and poppers), knives, toy weapons, tobacco/drug paraphernalia and/or items that promote the use of illicit substances or items deemed distasteful are prohibited. The Mission reserves the right to disallow the sale of any products deemed inappropriate for sale on Mission grounds. Weapons, ammunition, alcoholic beverages, or drugs are prohibited on the grounds at all times during, before, and after the event. Smoking of any substance is prohibited on Mission grounds, including e-cigarettes.

Animal Vendors: All animals must be kept in cages or on leashes at all times. The only exception will be competition or performance animals, and only during the competition or performance. The Vendor will be held liable for any incidents that may occur if an animal isn't properly restrained.

Food Vendors: Food vendors are responsible for knowing and meeting all San Diego County Health Department regulations. Vendor must provide a copy of current Health Department Food Facility Permit and post in booth and be prepared for a Health Department inspection. Proof of insurance for food vendors must be submitted prior to the day of the event.

Electricity: Electricity is not provided. Vendors may bring whisper quiet generators that meet California Air Quality requirements only. No generators without prior approval.

Taxes and Insurance: All applications must include California State Board of Equalization Seller's permit number. You are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax.

Clean-up: Vendors are responsible for complete clean-up, including all trash, of their booth space after the event. All vendors with animals are responsible for cleaning up all animal feces.

Children may not be left unattended in vendor booths.

Refunds: Vendors who cancel before September 4, 2026 will receive 50% refund of the booth fee, refunds after that date will not be granted. There are no refunds due to inclement weather or acts of nature.
